



## INDEPENDENT SUPPORT SERVICE

- Are you the parent/carer of a child or young person having their Statement of Special Educational Needs (SEN) transferred to an Education, Health and Care (EHC) Plan?
- Are you a young person that wants to know how you can play a key role in producing your EHC Plan?
- Do you want to find out more about the EHC process, Personal Budgets, or how to request an EHC assessment?

Core Assets Children's Services are providing the local **Independent Support Service** in partnership with Staffordshire County Council, Staffordshire SEND Family Partnership Service and Staffordshire Parent Action Network. This is a FREE service providing confidential and impartial information and support for parents, carers and young people (aged 0 to 25 years) to find their way through the changes to the Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) system, including the EHC transfer and assessment processes.

## HOW CAN AN INDEPENDENT SUPPORTER HELP ME

- Act as a named contact person throughout the EHC assessment and planning process.
- Providing you with support through the process of transferring a statement of SEN to an EHC plan.
- Work with you if you are new to EHC referrals
