Dear Parent/Guardian,

We hope that you are enjoying the summer break and that the students are having an opportunity to wind down after an energetic end to the term. We are very excited to be welcoming all students back to school in September and return to some form of normality that we have all been craving.

### **School Buildings**

In line with DFE guidance, the school will no longer operate in year group bubbles and therefore the school buildings and site will return, in most areas, to the way in which it operated before, with staff teaching in designated classrooms/community areas and students moving around site. This return to previous use will mean that more specialised equipment and rooms will be available for specific subjects for all year groups, such as science labs and PE equipment. All new Year 7 students will have an opportunity to familiarise themselves with the site during summer school as well as having a site tour on their first day. Students moving into Year 8 have had an organised tour in July and this will be repeated with their tutor on their first day to ensure that they feel comfortable using the entire site for lessons. Students will also be able to access food from both upper and lower canteens as previously and Parent Pay will continue to be the payment method.

### **Uniform and Equipment**

In order to facilitate learning, all students should have with them each day a basic set of equipment (see visual guide attached). Year 7 will be issued with a whiteboard, pen, and rubber in September, however, should they be lost, they will need to be replaced by students. Please see the policy for the full equipment list.

Students will spend until lunchtime on their first day with their tutor and will get a session on returning to school, receive their timetables, as well as a tour of the school (Y7/8) and more importantly an opportunity to speak with their tutor about their experiences/worries and reengage with each other.

### Covid-19

In line with DFE guidance, the wearing of facemasks is no longer expected, however should students or staff wish to continue to wear facemasks, particularly in communal areas, then this is at an individual person's discretion. The school will continue to keep other measures in place to keep us safe such as maintaining fresh air flow through the buildings, hand sanitising stations located throughout the school and regular cleaning of touch points such as doors/handrails and toilets throughout the day. Students and staff should continue to test regularly using lateral flow tests and students/staff who test positive or develop symptoms will still be asked to follow the most up to date guidance regarding testing and isolation. Track and trace will from the 18 July now be conducted by NHS test and trace.

We appreciate that returning to the use of the whole school site following a significant period of operating in year group bubbles will be daunting for both students and staff, and we endeavour to support each other through this. However, if you or your child have specific concerns about them returning to school, please do get in touch (see all Directors of Year/Leadership Team e-mail addresses in the contact section of the website) so that we can support you, reassure and alleviate any concerns that you may have. Additionally if you have a concern regarding a process or procedure that is put in place, please do speak to us about it directly, as we are, as you can image, navigating these ever changing circumstances with staff and student safety at the forefront of all that we are doing, but welcome feedback and questions that challenge us to make school the safe and welcoming place it should be.

We look forward to seeing all our students, old and new, in September for another exciting academic year.
