

Lockdown Procedure: Information for Parents/Carers

Our school has a carefully developed Lockdown Procedure designed to keep students and staff safe in the unlikely event of an emergency situation that requires us to secure the site.

A lockdown may be initiated, for example, if there is an incident or threat in the local area, or on rare occasions, when it is safer for everyone to remain inside the building.

- Staff and students regularly take part in awareness activities and drills to ensure they know what to do calmly and safely.
- Communication with parents would take place as soon as it is safe and appropriate to do so.
- Please avoid calling or coming to the school during a lockdown, as this could delay emergency services and communication processes.

Our procedures are developed with advice from the national guidance, local authority and police and they form part of our wider safeguarding framework.
