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PSHE

PSHE will continue in Year 12 and Year 13, but it will look slightly different to maybe what you have seen before. Destinations Programme

At Cannock Chase High School Sixth Form, we are committed to ensuring that all our students can move to the university, apprenticeship, or job of their choice, having the skills they need to succeed.

We start our Destinations programme in January of Year 12, when we visit a university. This encourages all of Year 12 to start thinking about whether they want to apply for university, and what type of university they may want to consider applying to. We then continue this theme throughout the Spring and Summer Term, with a variety of outside speakers and PSHE input. This culminates in the organisation of Destinations at the end of Year 12, where we visit both outside organisations, but also encourage speakers to attend school. We ensure that students have a variety of information covering university, apprenticeships, and employment. As a Sixth Form, we have developed close links with:

Virtual Learning

There are a few apps that you can download in preparation for your child's start at Cannock Chase High School.

Satchel One: Show My Homework

SMHW Pins- A pin is required when the student first registers. A pin can only be used once. Pins will be allocated to both the student and the parent once you are enrolled on to our school system.



Sims Parent App

You will be sent an invitation by email. This app allows you to access your child's daily school data, displaying achievement and behaviour points. This is also where your child's reports will be sent to.



FROG

This app is for our students. Their username is the same user name (CCHS1234) and password that they use to get onto the school computers.
