

Cannock Chase High School (16-19 Tuition Fund)

As part of our continual drive to improve standards and opportunities for our students in the Sixth Form, we have received £5,297 to be used for tuition for 16–19-year-olds, principally those who have not yet achieved a Grade 4 in English Language and/or Mathematics.

We firmly believe that students are most successful when receiving quality-first teaching in preparation for their English and/or Mathematics examinations. For this reason, we have made the decision to use the funding to timetable intensive revision lessons for both English and/or Mathematics, in small groups with specialist support.

Our students are taught in small groups with specialist teachers of English Language and Mathematics. They have received support including:

- Knowledge Retention Strategies
- Topic based revision and teaching
- Exam Preparation
- Independent study skills for Mathematics and English Language
- Further teaching of key concepts and skills, particularly as students did not sit their examinations in the Summer 2021 season.

We are committed to ensuring that all our students make progress towards their Level 2 English Language and/or Mathematics qualification.
